



Exploring Atlanta through



MARTA is Atlanta's rail and bus public transportation system. Visit www.itsmarta.com for information about routes, schedules, fares, and how to ride.

Guests arriving through Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport should first retrieve luggage, then follow the directional signage to the airport's MARTA station. There will be fare vending machines inside the station. These machines accept payment cards and US dollars. Most guests will want to buy a \$1.00 Breeze ticket and purchase a round trip fare for \$2.50 each way for a grand total of \$6.00.

If you plan on using MARTA for more than one round trip to the hotel and back, consider purchasing more than the round trip fare on a paper ticket (which can't be reloaded) or purchasing the plastic Breeze Card (which can be reloaded).



You can also download the Breeze Mobile 2 app from the Apple Store and Google Play. Please know that a prior version of the Breeze Mobile app is being phased out and you will want to download Breeze Mobile 2, which has a blue background for its logo. By downloading the app and making an account, you should be able to skip purchasing a ticket or card at the machines and only have to pay the fares electronically.

MARTA has two additional apps available in the Apple Store and Google Play:

- MARTA On The Go: provides real time bus tracking and rail station schedules. If you are walking from Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport to the Hilton, please know that you will only need to ride the rails (no buses needed).
- MARTA See & Say 2.0: This app helps riders stay in touch with MARTA Police.

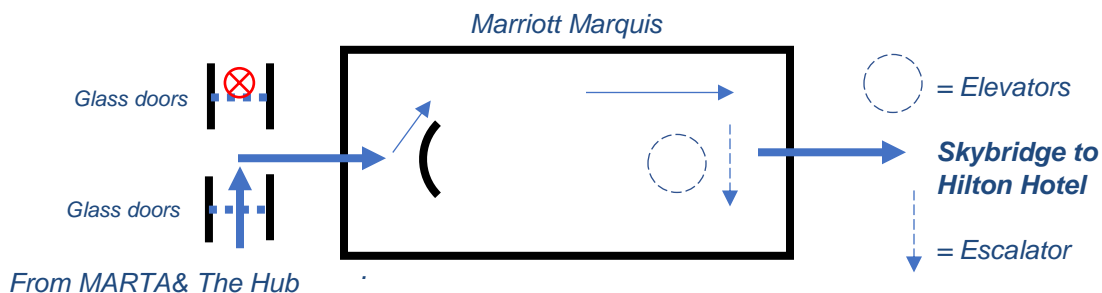
The closest rail station to the Hilton is the **Peachtree Center** station.

Five Points Station is not far away from the Hilton and is the main station for the entire MARTA system.



Walking Directions from the Airport MARTA Station to The Hilton Atlanta

- Guests can board ANY TRAIN at the Airport MARTA station and never have to transfer! After approximately 18 minutes, guests should step off at the Peachtree Center Station and follow signs to the Peachtree Center Mall, also known as The Hub.
- There is a steep escalator which will take guests up to street level. Guests who cannot use the escalator should see the accessible directions, also included with this document.
- Take a right at the top of the escalator and enter Peachtree Center Mall/The Hub through the sliding glass doors. **Note: The Hub is open only from 5:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. If you would arrive at The Hub late or early, consider NOT taking MARTA but taking rideshare or a taxi from the airport.**
- Start walking through the Food Court. Turn left where you see “The Hub” wall signage and Caribou Coffee. You’ll see a ceiling sign with an arrow pointing towards the Marriott and Hilton on the right.
- When you make this right turn, you will be walking past Yami Yami Sushi on your left, then Aviva by Kameel on your right. Walk through the next set of sliding glass doors onto the bridge veering left.
- At the end of the bridge will be a small ramp. Walk down this ramp and continue walking towards the new office building’s security desk.
- Turn left at the security desk, walking past the escalators through another set of sliding glass doors. Turn right once inside the doors. You’ll then be required to turn left.
- Walk through just one more set of sliding glass doors in front of you (do not walk through the second set). Turn right and walk into the atrium of the Marriott Marquis. You will now be on what’s called the “Atrium Level” of their hotel. Veer left, walking in front of the curved doors of the Atrium Ballroom.
- You should now be near the top of a downward escalator on your right. Go down two floors. If you can’t use the escalator, use the nearby elevators and go down two floors, then walk towards the foot of the escalators.



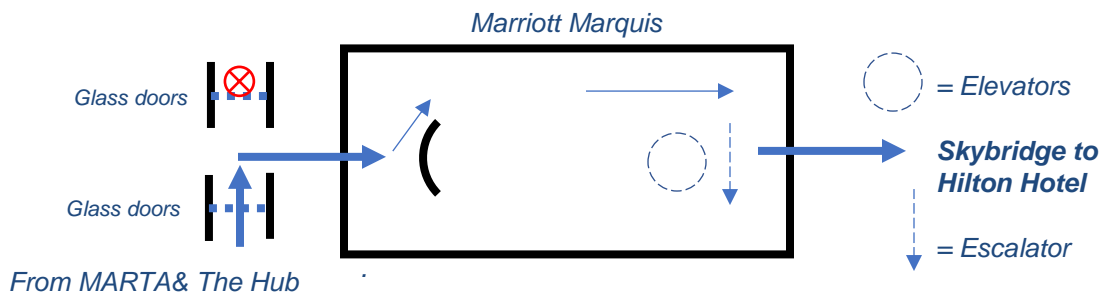
- Follow signage on this level identifying the “Skybridge to Hilton Hotel” and walk across the bridge. You will now be on the second floor of the Hilton.
- Walk down the small sets of steps or ramp and veer right towards the Hilton’s atrium elevators. Take an elevator down to the first floor lobby to check in.

Accessible Directions from the Airport MARTA Station to The Hilton Atlanta

- Guests can board ANY TRAIN at the Airport MARTA station and never have to transfer! After approximately 18 minutes, guests should step off at the Peachtree Center Station and follow signs to the Peachtree Center Mall, also known as The Hub.
- Take the elevator up to Peachtree Street. [Visit this link on Google Maps](#) to see where the MARTA elevator meets Peachtree Street and the nearby establishments around it, up to the courtyard mentioned below.
- Turn to your right, walking to the corner with Chase Bank, then turn left to cross the street to the Hard Rock Café. Turn left again and walk down Peachtree Street.
- Half a block down will be a courtyard between 225 and 235 Peachtree Street buildings. Turn right and walk to the end of this courtyard with two sets of doors labeled “Peachtree Center.”
- Instead of entering these doors, turn left and keep your eyes open for a set of glass doors on your right as you turn the corner. These doors will have an automatic door button plus a mat announcing entry into “The Hub.” Enter these doors. **Note: The Hub is open only from 5:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. If you would arrive at The Hub late or early, consider NOT taking MARTA but taking alternate transportation from the airport.**
- You are on the Plaza Level. Use the elevators on your right and take them down one floor to The Hub Level. You will now exit the elevators in front of Firehouse Subs.
- Turn left, walking straight to the glass wall window. Follow ceiling signage to the Marriott.
- When you make a right turn near the wall and ATM, you will be walking past Aviva by Kameel on your right. Walk through the next set of sliding glass doors onto the bridge veering left.
- At the end of the bridge will be a small ramp. Walk down this ramp and continue walking towards the new office building’s security desk.
- Turn left at the security desk, walking past the escalators through another set of sliding glass doors. Turn right once inside the doors. You’ll then be required to turn left.
- Walk through just one more set of sliding glass doors in front of you (do not walk through the second set). Turn right and walk into the atrium of the Marriott Marquis. You will now be on what’s called the “Atrium Level” of their hotel. Veer left, walking in front of the curved doors of the Atrium Ballroom.
- Towards the end of the atrium, you’ll see the bank of elevators on your right. Take them down two floors to the Marquis level.



- Follow signage on this level identifying the “Skybridge to Hilton Hotel” and walk across the bridge. You will now be on the second floor of the Hilton.
- Walk down the small sets of steps or ramp and veer right towards the Hilton’s atrium elevators. Take an elevator down to the first floor lobby to check in.
